ORDER

APP, Syed Aamir Shah for the State and Aurangzeb Khan Advocate for accused/petitioners present. Record received. Arguments heard and record gone through.

- 2. Accused/petitioners, Saeed Ur Rehman s/o
 Sunnat Khan and Hazrat Bilal s/o Saleem Gul seek
 their release on bail in case FIR No. 16, dated
 16.06.2021, U/S 16AA & 5 Explosive Act at
 Police Station Mishti Mela, wherein, as per
 contents of FIR, the local police have recovered a
 rocket launcher M72 alongwith 06 shells and 08
 detonators from the motorcycle bearing
 registration no. F1017/Hangu, riding by the present
 accused/petitioners.
- 3. It is evident from the record that though both the accused/petitioners are directly nominated in the FIR and the offence for which the accused/petitioners are charged falls within the

prohibitory clause of section 497 Cr.P.C, however the recovery has not been effected from personal possession of either of the accused/petitioners rather from the motorcycle allegedly riding by the accused/petitioners with no specification of roles as to who was driving the motorcycle at the time of occurrence. Similarly, the report of FSL or that of the Arms Expert is not available on file as to confirm that whether the recovered arms and ammunitions were in working condition or otherwise. Both the aforementioned circumstances throw the case against the accused/petitioners within the ambit of further inquiry of section 497 Cr.P.C.

4. Hence, in view of what is discussed above, the accused/petitioners are admitted to the concession of bail provided each of the accused/petitioners submit a bail bond in the sum of Rs. 200,000/- with two sureties, each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this court. Consign.
