		3. Mr. Saleem Khan SHO of Police Station Ghiljo,
		Orakzai was reportedly available on barricade. A land
		cruiser jeep of red wine color bearing registration No.
		SAH-27 was stopped for search at check post. Dast Ali Jan
		s/o Khaista Khan was driving the vehicle; Muhammad
		Ishtiq s/o Abdul Kamal was setting on front seat; whereas,
		Asif alias Faiz Khan s/o Sharbat Khan was setting on
		second seat of the vehicle. On suspicion, the vehicle was
		searched; 03 packets measuring 1100 grams each with total
		of 3300 grams of chars were found in possession of person
		setting in second seat of the vehicle. A 9mm pistol bearing
		No. TFM-20671 with fixed charger and live rounds was
		recovered from the driver and one bottle locally
		manufactured wine was recovered from the man on front
		seat. Criminal Law was brought into motion against the
		accused and resultantly, FIR bearing No. 27 dated:
		29/07/2021 was registered against the accused by attracting

Assistant Public Prosecutor for state were heard at length and file gone through.

- 5. This is tentative assessment of record available on file as deep appreciation of case file is neither required nor warranted at this stage. The accused/petitioner was allegedly carrying Pistol 9mm bearing TFM-20671 and was arrested on the spot. The role given to accused/petitioner is merely Pistol for which learned counsel for the accused presented valid license 1-1-0015640/Peshawar while arguing instant petition. The case of accused/petitioner is not falling within the ambit of prohibitory Clause of Section-497 of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1898 as well. Investigation is complete and keeping the accused behind the bar will serve no purpose.
- 6. For what has been discussed above, instant bail petition stands allowed subject to furnishing bail bonds to tune of rupees 120000/-; with two sureties; each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this Court. File of this Court be consigned to District Record Room after its necessary completion and compilation within the span allowed for; whereas, copy of this Order be placed on record of Police to be returned accordingly.
