- 5. This is tentative assessment of record available on file as deep appreciation of case file is neither required nor warranted at this stage. The accused/petitioner was allegedly having a bottle of locally manufactured wine and was arrested on the spot. The role given to accused/petitioner is merely having possession of one bottle wine with no allegation of sale purchase. The case of accused/petitioner is not falling within the ambit of prohibitory Clause of Section-497 of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1898; whereas, investigation is complete and keeping the accused behind the bar will serve no purpose.
- 6. For what has been discussed above, instant bail petition stands allowed subject to furnishing bail bonds to tune of rupees 120000/-; with two sureties; each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this Court. File of this Court be consigned to District Record Room after its necessary completion and compilation within the span allowed for; whereas, copy of this Order be placed on record of Police to be returned accordingly.
