REHMAT ULLAH VS THE STATE

ORDER

DPP, Umar Niaz for the State and Aurangzeb Khan Advocate for accused/petitioner present. Arguments heard and record gone through.

2. Accused/petitioner, **Rehmat Ullah** s/o Naimat Khan seeks his post-arrest bail in case FIR No. 39, dated 30.09.2023 registered U/S 9 (d) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa CNSA at Police Station Mishti Mela, wherein, as per contents of FIR, the police having laid a picket were present on the spot where a person walking on foot having a bag on his shoulder on seeing the police party tried to escape but he was overpowered. The search of the bag led the complainant to the recovery of 08 packets of chars, each weighing 1000 grams, a total of 8000 grams. Hence, the present FIR.


3. It is evident from the record that the accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the FIR

with a huge quantity of chars recovered from his possession. The offence for which the accused/petitioner is charged, attracts prohibitory clause of section 497 Cr.P.C. Moreover, sufficient material is available on file which reasonably connect the accused/petitioner with the commission of offence. Hence, the accused/petitioner is not entitled for the concession of bail at this stage. Accordingly, for the stated reasons, bail petition in hand stands dismissed being meritless. Consign.
