- 1. Petitioner Mst. Armina Naz widow of Muhammad Imran R/O District Orakzai, being real mother, have filed the instant petition for her appointment as Guardian for her children/minors namely 1. Muhammad Usman aged about 05 years, 2. Umar Farooq aged about 1 year and 3. Bibi Asia aged about 3.5 years. According to petitioner, the above-named minors are residing with her and she being real mother is natural guardian of the minors. That in absence of father of the minors, she is entitled for her appointment as guardian of the minors as she can take better care of the welfare of the minors than any other person.
- 2. Notice to respondents i.e., public at large was issued in daily newspaper "Ausaf" dated 09.09.2023, but no one appeared before the court, so ex-parte proceedings were initiated.
