Complainant Fazal Warshah present in person.</p> <p>Today, the date was fixed for arguments; however, the parties submitted a compromise deed out of the court vide which the complainant has got no objection upon the acquittal of the petitioners/convicts. Statement of the complainant recorded and placed on file.</p> <p>I heard arguments and perused the record.</p> <p>It is evident from the record that accused Noor Khaliq and Dilawar Khan were convicted in case no. 50, dated 09.10.2020 of PS Ghiljo for the offence u/s 337-F(v)/337-A(i)/337-F(i)/34 PPC vide judgment dated 21.01.2022 of learned Judicial Magistrate/MTMC/CJ-I, Orakzai, as trial.</p> <p>Being aggrieved, the convicts named above filed the instant appeal.</p> <p>During course of appeal, the parties effected compromise vide which complainant pardoned the convicts in the name of Almighty Allah and raised no objection on the acquittal of the accused. As the offences for which the accused are convicted, are compoundable and the complainant is not going to proceed further with the case raising no objection on the acquittal of the convicts; therefore in the best interest of the parties, the compromise is accepted. The Impugned judgment/order of learned Judicial Magistrate/MTMC/CJ-I, Orakzai is set aside. The convicts named above are acquitted of the charges levelled against them. Accused are in custody. They be released forthwith, if not required in any other case.
