ORDER

APP, Syed Amir Shah for the State and Sana Ullah Khan Advocate for accused/petitioner present. Record received. Arguments heard and record gone through.

2. Accused/petitioner, Abbas Khan s/o Utman Khel seeks his post-arrest bail in case FIR No. 02, dated 14.01.2022 registered U/S 9 (d) of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa CNSA at Police Station Mishti Mela, wherein, as per contents of FIR, the local police acting on information regarding smuggling of narcotics, laid a picket on the spot where a motorcycle riding by accused/petitioner was stopped. A sack tied with muffler on back of accused was searched, which led the complainant to the recovery of 09 packets of chars, each weighing 1000 grams, a total of 9000 grams. Hence, the present FIR.

3. It is evident from the record that the accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the FIR with a huge quantity of chars recovered from his possession. The offence for which the accused/petitioner is charged, attracts prohibitory clause of section 497 Cr.P.C. Moreover, sufficient material is available on file which reasonably connect the accused/petitioner with the commission of offence. The points raised by the learned counsel for accused/petitioner involve deep appreciation of merits which cannot be discussed at this stage. Hence, the accused/petitioner is not entitled for the concession of bail at this stage. Accordingly, for the stated reasons, bail petition in hand stands dismissed being meritless. Consign.
