DPP, Umar Niaz for the State present. Counsel for the accused/petitioner submitted written arguments through his junior. Placed on file. Arguments of the learned DPP heard, the written arguments submitted by counsel for accused/petitioner and the available record gone through.

Shaukat Ahmbd Khale Shaukat Ahmbd Khale District & Sessions Judge, Orakzai at Baber Meia Accused/petitioner, Gul Mir s/o Ghalji seek his release on bail in case FIR No. 97, dated 01.08.2021 registered U/S 9 (d) KP CNSA at Police Station Kalaya Lower Orakzai, wherein, as per contents of FIR, the complainant alongwith other police officials having laid a picket, where a motorcycle riding by two persons was stopped. The person of the present accused was searched which led the complainant to the recovery of 9 packets of chars each weighing 1200 grams a total

of 10800 grams of chars (Gardah) from the waist coat worn by the accused/petitioner. The accused disclosed his name as Gul Mir, the present accused/petitioner.

It is evident from the record that the accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the FIR with a huge quantity of chars recovered from his possession. Moreover, the offence for which the accused/petitioner is charged, attracts prohibitory clause of section 497 Cr.P.C. Furthermore, sufficient material is available on file which reasonable connect the accused/petitioner with the commission of offence. Hence, the accused/petitioner is not entitled for the concession of bail at this stage. Accordingly, for the stated reasons, bail petition in hand stands dismissed being meritless. Consign.
