ORDER

DPP, Umar Niaz for the State and Jabir Hussain Advocate for accused/petitioner present. Arguments heard and record gone through.

2. Accused/petitioner, Mumtaz Ali s/o Amjad Ali seek his release on bail in case FIR No. 24, dated 08.10.2021 registered U/S 9 (d) KP CNSA at Police Station Kurez Lower Orakzai, wherein, as per contents of FIR, the complainant acting on secret information regarding smuggling of huge quantity of narcotics, laid a picket on this part of occurrence, where at about 14.00 hours a person walking on foot on way toward the picket having a plastic sack in his hand, on seeing the police party tried to escape but he was overpowered. The search of the sack led the complainant to the recovery of 10 packets of chars each weighing 500grams, a total of 5000 grams of chars. The

accused disclosed his name as Mumtaz Ali, the present accused/petitioner.

3. It is evident from the record that the accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the FIR with a huge quantity of chars recovered from his possession. Moreover, the offence for which the accused/petitioner is charged, attracts prohibitory clause of section 497 Cr.P.C. Furthermore, sufficient material is available on file which reasonable connect the accused/petitioner with the commission of offence. Hence, the accused/petitioner is not entitled for the concession of bail at this stage. Accordingly, for the stated reasons, bail petition in hand stands dismissed being meritless. Consign.
