Hence, the present FIR.</p> <p>Arguments heard and record perused. The accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the FIR. Counsel for the accused/petitioner failed to point out any malafidi or ulterior motive on behalf of the complainant or local police for falsely implicating them in the instant case. Hence, the accused/petitioner is not entitled to concession of pre-arrest bail at this stage.
