

Order No.4	30/11/2023	<p>Mr. Abid Ali Advocate for accused/petitioner; complainant along with counsel and DyPP for State are in attendance.</p> <p>2. Arguments heard; whereas, this is the disposal of Post arrest bail application presented by accused/petitioner Sher Khan s/o Akbar Shah resident of Qaum Mishti, District Orakzai.</p> <p>3. Shah Nawaz being complainant, booked the accused Sher Khan along with his co-accused for committing the theft of different articles used in the coal mine. Criminal Law was brought into motion against the accused and resultantly, Daily Diary No.9 was converted into FIR No. 43 dated: 27.10.2023 which was registered against the accused under Section 379/34 of the Pakistan Penal Code, 1860 in Kurez Boya Police Station, Orakzai. The present accused was arrested who was later on remanded to Judicial Lockup. Consequently, application for release of accused/petitioner on bail was received.</p> <p>4. Learned counsel for accused/petitioner and Deputy Public Prosecutor for State assisted by counsel for the complainant were heard at length and file gone through.</p> <p>5. This is tentative assessment of record available on file as deep appreciation of evidence is neither required nor warranted. The matter is reported to the Police with two days delay. There is no source of information. The recovery was effected from open ground and not from secret place on the pointation of the complainant. More so, there is no previous criminal history of accused/petitioner about his involvement in such nature cases as per available record. All these facts renders the case of petitioner as one of further inquiry.</p> <p>6. For what has been discussed above, instant bail petition stands allowed subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the tune of Rupees 100,000/- with two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this Court. Sureties must be local, reliable and men of means.</p>
