

<p><b>Order No.05</b></p>	<p>04.12.2023</p>	<p>DPP, Umar Niaz for the State present. Accused Ihsan Ullah on bail along with his counsel present. Complainant Gulistan Khan present in person.</p> <p>Today, the case was fixed for prosecution evidence but at the very outset, the father of the deceased submitted that he has got no objection upon the acquittal of the accused. To this effect, his statement is recorded and placed on file. Arguments heard and record gone through.</p> <p>Perusal of case file reveals that the accused named above is charged for the murder of his own brother Muhammad Ayaz, vide FIR No. 14, Dated 30.07.2023, u/s 302 PPC of the Ghiljo Police Station wherein on that day the police, prompted by information about a deceased individual at DHQ Hospital, reached the hospital and discovered the lifeless body of Muhammad Ayaz murdered/killed with firearm. Moreover, the bail order issued on the 18th of September 2023 by the learned Additional Sessions Judge-II, Orakzai, hints at an out-of-court settlement between the involved parties.</p> <p>In these circumstances, pursuing the trial against the accused appears to be an exercise in futility. Consequently, <b>Ihsan Ullah</b>, the accused facing trial, is hereby acquitted of all charges in the present case. Notably, he is currently out on bail. The bonds securing his bail stand cancelled, and his sureties are discharged of the liabilities of the bail bonds.</p> <p>Order announced.
