## **ORDER**

DPP Umar Niaz for the State, Syed Muzahir Hussain Advocate for complainant and Imad Azam Advocate for accused/petitioner present. Arguments heard and record gone through.

2. The accused/petitioner Khalid Noor s/o Hajat Noor seeks his post arrest bail in case FIR no. 29, dated 26.08.2019, u/s 302/34 PPC of PS Kalaya, wherein as per contents of FIR, the complainant Mst. Sajida Bibi on 26.08.2019 at 2230 hours at Civil Hospital Kalaya made a report to the local police to the fact that on that day at Shaukat Ahi sud about 1930 hours, she was present at her house District & Sessions Mela Orakzai at Baber Mela when an altercation took place with her step-sons namely Sajjad and Khalid Noor. Meanwhile, on entry of her husband to the house after offering maghrib prayer, the present accused/petitioner caught hold of him (her husband) while the accused Sajjad stabbed her husband with a knife at the direction of the present accused/petitioner. injured while shifting to KDA Hospital with the help of Alif Noor and others, succumbed to injuries on way. Hence, the present FIR.

- 3. It is evident from the record that the accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the FIR and the offence for which the accused/petitioner is charged falls within the prohibitory clause of 497 Cr.P.C. Moreover, the accused/petitioner has remained fugitive from law for about more than 02 years.
- 4. Hence, in view of what is discussed above, it is held that sufficient material is available on file which reasonably connect the accused/petitioner with the commission of offence; therefore, he is not entitled to the concession of bail at this stage. The instant post-arrest bail application is thus turned down. Copy of this order placed on judicial/police file. Consign.
