		disposal of Pre arrest bail application presented by
		accused/petitioners Muhammad Abbas son of Syed
		Muhammad Kaleem resident of Qaum Mishti, Tappa
		Chappar, District Orakzai and Fateh Muhammad son of
		Gothi Khan resident of Shapoor District Shangla.
		3. Brief facts of the case are such that mine accident
		has been occurred in extraction of coal mine in Mine No. 4
,		which is owned by Syed Muhammad Abbas son of Syed
		Muhammad Khalil located in the leasing area of Mr.
		Shaheen. This untoward incident has taken precious lives
		of three mine workers. The last known reason of such
		incident reported by the Inspector of Mines Orakzai is
		violation of prescribed safety measures. The complainant
		assigned the reason of incident as leakage of water supply
		pipes. The happening was recorded vide Naqalmad No. 10
		dated 19-04-2022. Consequently, FIR bearing No. 11 dated
		27-10-2021 was registered in Police Station of Kurez Boya
		of Orakzai by attracting Section 322 of the Pakistan Penal
		Code, 1860. The petitioners moved the Court with
		application for pre-arrest bail which is under consideration.
		4. Arguments of counsel for the accused/petitioners and
		learned Sr.PP for State heard and record perused.
		5. On tentative assessment of record, it reveals that
	γ	violation of prescribed standard of safety measures has
	O S	been done and leakage of water aggravated the risk that had
		taken the precious lives of 03 mines workers. All of the
	N 20 2	petitioners have specifically been charged during technical

assessment. Above all, neither mala fide nor intention to disgrace and dishonor the accused on part of the complainant or prosecution is being surfaced.

6. For what has been discussed above, instant pre arrest bail petition stands dismissed. Ad-interim pre arrest bail earlier granted to the accused/petitioners is hereby recalled. File of this Court be consigned to District Record Room after its necessary completion and compilation within the span allowed for; whereas, copy of this Order be placed on record of Police to be returned accordingly.
