			resident of Qaum Mishti, District Orakzai.
			3. Brief facts of the case are such that mine accident
			has been occurred in extraction of coal mine in Mine No. 4
			which is owned by Syed Muhammad Abbas son of Syed
			Muhammad Khalil located in the leasing area of Mr.
			Shaheen. This untoward incident has taken precious lives
			of three mine workers. The last known reason of such
			incident reported by the Inspector of Mines Orakzai is
			violation of prescribed safety measures. The complainant
			assigned the reason of incident as leakage of water supply
	•		pipes. The happening was recorded vide Naqalmad No. 10
			dated 19-04-2022. Consequently, FIR bearing No. 11 dated
			27-10-2021 was registered in Police Station of Kurez Boya
			of Orakzai by attracting Section 322 of the Pakistan Penal
			Code, 1860. The petitioner moved the Court with
			application for pre-arrest bail which is under consideration.
			4. Arguments of counsel for the accused/petitioner and
			learned Sr.PP for State heard and record perused.
			5. On tentative assessment of record, it reveals that
			violation of prescribed standard of safety measures has
		_	been done and leakage of water aggravated the risk that had
