| Order No.07 | 19.05.2022 | <p>DPP, Umar Niaz for the State, Abid Ali Advocate for complainant and Amad Azam Advocate for accused/petitioners present. Accused/petitioner, Muhammad Ibrar and Muhammad Ismail on ad-interim pre-arrest bail present. Complainant Asif Nawaz present in person. Arguments heard.</p> <p>The accused/petitioners, Muhammad Ibrar s/o Abdul Wahid and Muhammad Ismail s/o Pir Gul seek confirmation of their ad-interim pre-arrest bail in case FIR no. 10, dated 18.04.2022, u/s 342/506/355/34 of PS Kurez Boya, wherein as per contents of FIR, on 16.03.2022 at 09:20 hours, the complainant made a report to the police to the fact that he is a student of class 6 in Chappar Mishti School and as per his daily routine he used to go to school at 08:00 am and return to home at 1420 hours, that on 15.03.2022 as usual he was on his way to school via motorcycle, when reached near Eidgah, the accused/petitioners duly armed stopped the complainant and took him to Eidgah where they illegally confined him till 1300 hours. Hence, the present FIR.</p> <p>Perusal of the case file shows that both the accused/petitioners are directly nominated in the instant FIR. Counsel for the accused/petitioner failed to point out any malafidi or ulterior motive on behalf of the complainant or local police for falsely implicating him in the instant case. Hence, the accused/petitioner is not entitled to concession of pre-arrest bail at this stage.
