Record received.</p> <p>The accused/petitioners, <b>Fayyaz Ali, Subhan Ali, Sadiq Ali and Muhammad Bashir</b> all sons of Jang Ali, r/o Kalat Tehsil Lower, District Orakzai seek confirmation of their ad-interim pre-arrest bail in case FIR no. 21, dated 26.02.2022, u/s 3/4 Ghag Act of PS Kalaya wherein, as per contents of FIR, the complainant has charged the accused/petitioners for raising Ghag, restraining the daughters and nieces of complainant of marrying someone else.</p> <p>At the very outset, complainant submitted a compromise deed reached between the parties out of the court. The complainant submitted that he has got no objection either upon the release of accused/petitioners on bail or upon their acquittal at the trial stage. To that effect statement of the complainant recorded and placed on file. Arguments heard and record gone through.</p> <p>Perusal of case file shows that though the offence for which the accused/petitioners are charged, is non-compoundable but as the parties are close relatives; therefore, in the best interest of justice, the compromise is accepted and the ad-interim pre-arrest bail allowed to the accused/petitioners vide order dated 11.05.2022 of this court is confirmed on the strength of existing bail bonds.
