

Similarly, 1<sup>st</sup> part of section 506 PPC is also bailable. Though, 2<sup>nd</sup> part of 506 PPC is non-bailable, yet the contents of FIR depict that there is nothing ~~allegation~~ against the accused that they have extended threats to cause death, grievous or destruction of any property belonging to the complainant, hence in such like circumstances 2<sup>nd</sup> part of section 506 PPC is not attracted. As all the offences leveled against the accused/petitioner are bailable in nature, hence petition in hand is accepted and accused/petitioner is released on bail subject to furnishing of bail bonds to the tune of Rs: 80,000/- with two local sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of the court.
