JUDGEMENT 15.06.2022

> The above-named accused are charged for the offence u/s 9 (d) KP CNSA vide FIR No. 75, dated 14.06.2021 of Police Station Kalaya.

As per contents of FIR, the complainant along with other (2).police officials were present on barricade, where two persons were riding on Motorcycle and were stopped on suspicion, driver of the Motorcycle disclosed his name as Rahim ullah. He was searched which led the complainant to the recovery of 2000 grams of chars.

Similarly, the second person who was setting on rear seat of the Motorcycle disclosed his name as Abdul Wahid. He was also

searched which led the complainant to the recovery of 3000 grams of chars.

- (3). After completion of investigation, complete challan was put in court. The accused were summoned, copies of the documents were provided to him u/s 265-C of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1898. Charge was framed against them to which they pleaded not guilty and claimed trial.
- (4). The prosecution was directed to produce evidence. Today the case was fixed for evidence of the prosecution; however, the accused submitted application for disposal of their case on the basis of plead guilty for the reasons that they are Juvenile and ready for social services, having poor financial status and that being first offenders, lenient view may be taken against them. Application is placed on file. Statements of the accused recorded u/s 342 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1898.
- shows that though the accused have pleaded not guilty to the charge already framed against them; however, they have confessed their guilt vide their application submitted today. The accused were having 2000 grams and 3000 grams of chars separately in their possession; therefore, they are held guilty of the offence punishable u/s 9 (d) of KP CNSA. Hence, they are convicted of the offence. But as the accused are first offender and there is no record of their previous involvement in such like offences. Besides, the accused are juvenile and having poor financial status; therefore, they must have a chance of repentance and reformation. Keeping in view the

aforementioned circumstances and the clean breast admission of the guilt of the accused, by taking a lenient view, instead of sentencing them at once, they are placed on probation for a period of two years subject to the executing of bonds in the sum of Rs. 80,000/- with two sureties to the effect that the accused would commit no offence and to keep the peace and be of good behavior during the period of bond and to appear and receive the sentence, if called upon to do so during that period, to the satisfaction of Probation Officer concerned. Case property be dealt with as per law after expiry of period of appeal/revision.

(6). File be consigned to District Record Room after necessary completion and compilation within span allowed for.
