DPP, Umar Niaz for the State and Zulqarnain Mehmood Advocate for accused/petitioner present. Record received. Arguments heard.

The accused/petitioner, Ahmad Gul s/o Injeer Gul seeks his post arrest bail in case FIR no. 12, dated 06.06.2022, u/s 302/311 PPC & 15AA of PS Ghiljo, wherein as per contents of FIR, on 06.06.2022 the local police on receipt of information regarding murder of Muneeb Ur Rehman s/o Siraj Gul and Mst. Nasreen Bibi d/o Injeer Gul on the pretext of honor reached Ghiljo hospital where Muneeb Ur Rehman and Mst. Nasreen Bibi were found murdered. The police also know that both were murdered by the present accused/petitioner on the pretext of having illicit relations relation with each other. Hence, the present FIR.





- 3. Arguments heard and record perused. Perusal of the file case shows that accused/petitioner is directly charged and the offence carries capital punishment. Moreover, the circumstantial evidence in the form of recoveries made from the spot and the recovery of the weapon of offence from possession of the accused connect him with the commission of offence. Furthermore, the occurrence has taken place inside the house of accused/petitioner but neither any male legal heir of deceased has made any report of the matter nor any explanation regarding unnatural death of both the deceased has furnished by the inmates of the house.
- 4. Hence, in view of what is discussed above, it is held that sufficient material is available on file which reasonably connect the accused/petitioner with the commission of offence; therefore, he is not entitled to the concession of bail at this stage. The instant post-arrest bail application is thus turned down. Copy of this order placed on judicial/police file. Consign.
