Original sale deed through which the present petitioner became owner and transfer letter from previous owner is produced before the court. Original receipt of token take challan up to date is also produced. Documents seen and returned. The vehicle in question was taken into possession from the present petitioner being accused in the above stated FIR. The petitioner is last possessor of the vehicle in question and there is no rival claimant. The vehicle in question is no more required to the local police for investigation. Detention of vehicle in question in police custody for indefinite period would also achieve no useful purpose.

Resultantly, the application is **Accepted** and it is directed that the vehicle in question be handed over to the petitioner, subject to surety bonds to the tune of Rs. 900,000/- with two sureties to the satisfaction of SHO Police Station concerned. Petitioner shall produce the same when and where required. Record be returned back to the quarter concerned.
