Order No.03</p>		<p>The accused was released on bail vide order dated 02.02.2022 of this court, however, after submission of challan and compliance of section 265-C CrPC, the accused absented himself, having gone abroad; therefore, he was proceeded u/s 512 CrPC and vide order dated 07.06.2022 of this court he was declared proclaimed offender after recording evidence in absentia. Hence, the present Bail Before Arrest petition.</p> <p>Arguments heard and record perused.
