## TAIMOOR VS THE STATE

## **ORDER**

DPP, Umar Niaz for the State and Sana Ullah Khan Advocate for accused/petitioner present. Record received. Arguments heard and record gone through.

2. Accused/petitioner, Taimoor s/o Nawab Khan seeks his post-arrest bail in case FIR No. 62, dated 15.06.2022 registered U/S 9 (d) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa CNSA at Police Station Kalaya, wherein, as per contents of FIR, the local police during patrolling having laid a picket on the spot, stopped a motorcar of white colour bearing no. FATA/B8851 driving by accused/petitioner, for the purpose of checking. Nothing incriminating was recovered from his personal search. The search of the motorcar led the complainant to the recovery of 08 packets of opium, each weighing 1000 grams (total 8000 grams of opium) from a



secret cavity made near oil tank of the motorcar.

Hence, the present FIR.

It is evident from the record that the accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the FIR with a huge quantity of narcotics recovered from his possession. The offence for which the accused/petitioner is charged, attracts prohibitory clause of section 497 Cr.P.C. Moreover, sufficient material is available on file which reasonably accused/petitioner connect the with commission of offence. The points raised by the learned counsel for accused/petitioner involve deep appreciation of merits which cannot be discussed Hence, this stage. the accused/petitioner is not entitled for the concession of bail at this stage. Accordingly, for the stated reasons, bail petition in hand stands dismissed being meritless. Copy of this order be placed on police/judicial file. Consign.
