

Order No.4	12.12.2023	<p>Accused/petitioners on ad-interim pre-arrest bail alongwith counsel present. Complainant in person and Mr. Amir Anjum DyPP for the State are in attendance.</p> <p>2. Through this order I shall dispose of BBA application presented by accused/petitioners namely 1. Ijaz son of Akram Khan 2. Nawab Khan son of Safdar 3. Khan Zali alias Khanoo son of Niaz Ali and 4. Wasid Ali son of Lal Zali all residents of Qaum Bezot, District Orakzai.</p> <p>3. Accused/petitioners, named above, seek confirmation of pre-arrest bail, after having been charged in case FIR No. 99 dated 22.10.2023, U/s 324/109/148/149 Pakistan Panel Code, 1860 registered at Kalaya Police Station, Orakzai.</p> <p>4. At the very outset, complainant appeared before the Court and stated at the bar that he has patched up the matter with the accused/petitioners and has got no objection if BBA petition of accused/petitioners is confirmed. To this effect, his statement recorded in the Court, wherein, he has confirmed the above facts and endorsed his no objection on confirmation of BBA of accused/petitioners. Copy of his CNIC has been exhibited as Ex.PA, which is placed on file. Since the parties have patched up the matter; therefore, keeping in view the above, the instant BBA petition is accepted and resultantly, ad-interim pre-arrest bail, already granted to the accused/petitioners vide Order 02 dated 02.12.2023 is confirmed on the existing bail bonds. Local police be informed accordingly.
