Accused/petitioner, Muhammad Ameen s/o Minar Shah seeks his post-arrest bail in case FIR No. 03 dated 24.01.2022 registered U/S 9 (d) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa CNSA, 2019 at Police Station Mishti Mela, wherein, as per contents of FIR, the complainant alongwith other police during routine patrolling were present on the spot, where at about 10:00 hours a person having a white colour bag on his shoulder, was stopped. The search of the bag led the complainant to the recovery of 10 packets of chars, each weighing 1000 grams, a total of 10,000 grams. Hence, the present FIR.

It is evident from the record that the accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the FIR with a huge quantity of chars recovered from his which offence for the possession.
