

Complainant Amjid Khan present in person.</p> <p>The above-named accused/petitioners seek confirmation of their ad-interim pre-arrest bail in case FIR No. 01, Dated 18.01.2024, u/s 452/436/427/34 PPC, Police Station Dabori wherein, as per contents of FIR, the complainant, Amjid Khan on 18.01.2024 made a report to the police to the fact that on 17.01.2024 he along with other family members were inside their residence when he heard a noise, upon which he came out of his room and saw the present accused/petitioners and co-accused Saif Ullah exiting the house through the main gate. He discovered that four rooms of his house and the woods were on fire, and the flames had also damaged various items within the rooms, including golden ornaments and cash amounting to Rs. 460,000/-. 
