The petitioners namely Kameen Gul s/o Shana Gul and Wazir Akbar s/o Abdul Akbar have applied for their post arrest bail in connection with case FIR No. 25, Dated: 22.11.2022, U/S 506/447/427/34 PPC registered in PS Dabori, U/Orakzai. Arguments heard and file perused. Though, accused are directly charged in the FIR but except sec. 506 PPC, all other sections for which accused are charged are bailable and also, do not come within the prohibitory clause of section 497 Cr.P.C, in such like cases the grant of bail is a rule while its refusal is an exception but there exist no exceptional circumstances in the present case. In addition to, accused are first offenders and have got no criminal history at their credit. For the above reason, the accused are entitled to the concession of bail at this stage, hence, application in hand is accepted subject to furnishing of bail bonds to the tune of Rs. 50,000/- with two local and reliable sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this court.
