SUIT FOR DECLARATION, PERMANENT AND MANDATORY INJUNCTION

SUMMARY JUDGEMENT: 31.08.2022

Shah has brought the instant suit for declaration, permanent and mandatory injunction against the defendants, referred hereinabove, seeking declaration therein that correct date of birth of the plaintiff is 03.04.1993, according to Matriculation Record while it has been wrongly mentioned as 1986 in the CNIC by the defendants, which is wrong, ineffective upon the rights of the plaintiff and liable to correct the date of birth of plaintiff but they refused, hence, the instant suit.

- 2. Defendants were summoned, who appeared through their representative namely Syed Farhat Abbas, who submitted authority letter and written statement.
- 3. During the scheduling conference within the meaning of order IX-A of CPC, it was revealed that the matter involved in the instant case is very petty in nature, which can be decided through summary judgement as per relevant record. To this effect notice was given to the parties that why not the case in hand be decided on the basis of available record without recording lengthy evidence, as the primary aim and objective of Amended Management Rules in CPC is, "to enable the court to
 - a. Deal with the cases justly and fairly;
 - b. Encourage parties to alternate dispute resolution procedure if it considers appropriate;
 - c. Save expense and time both of courts and litigants; and
 - d. Enforce compliance with provisions of this Code."

Record reveals that plaintiff through instant suit is seeking correction of date of birth to the effect that his correct date of birth is 03.04.1993 while it has been wrongly mentioned as 1986 in the CNIC by the defendants, which is wrong, ineffective upon the rights of the plaintiff and liable to correction. Plaintiff in support of his contention produced his Secondary School Certificate and Secondary School DMC, wherein, date of birth of the plaintiff is 03.04.1993. The said documents clearly negate the incorporation of date of birth of

the plaintiff as 1986 in his CNIC. Further, there is no countered document available with the defendants to rebut the document produced by the plaintiff in support of his contention. So, the available record clearly establishes the claim of the plaintiff.

- 5. Consequently, upon what has been discussed above and the jurisdiction vested in this court under order IX-A and XV-A of CPC, suit of the plaintiff succeeds and is hereby decreed as prayed for. Defendants are directed to correct the date of birth of plaintiff as 03.04.1993 in their record and in the CNIC of the plaintiff.
- 6. Parties are left to bear their own costs.
- 7. File be consigned to the District Record Room, Orakzai after its necessary completion and compilation.
