

Order No 06	28.10.2022	<p>Petitioners through counsel present.</p> <p>Through my this single order, I intend to dispose off the instant petition ex-parte.</p> <p>Ex-parte arguments heard and record perused.</p> <p>After hearing of ex-parte arguments and perusal of the record, I am of the opinion that the petitioner No. 01 is the sutan/co-wife of the deceased Mst. Khyalmanda and they both were the wives of the deceased Khyalbaz Khan. While the petitioner No. 02 is the daughter of petitioner No. 01 from the aforesaid Khyalbaz Khan and not the daughter of the deceased Khyalmanda. Both the witnesses produced before the court also narrated the same status of the petitioners.
