Attorney of petitioners present. Mr. Ijaz Advocate submitted fresh wakalatnama on behalf of petitioners. Respondents have already been placed ex-parte. Ex-parte arguments heard and record perused.

Through this order, this Court is going to dispose of an application submitted by the petitioners for provision of Succession Certificate.

Brief facts of the instant petition are that petitioners seek issuance of a Succession Certificate in their favour on the ground that they are the only legal heirs/successors of deceased Naseeb Ali S/O Momin Ali R/O Qoum Mamazai, Tappa Subzi Khel, Tehsil Lower, District Orakzai who died on 01.01.2022, copy of death certificate is placed on file. That the deceased has left no other legal heirs except the petitioners. That petitioners Neelum (Widow), Ali Hadi (son), Madiha, Saman Bibi, Hadees Kasa, and Minhal Bibi (daughters) are entitled to receive Rs. 495,703/- lying in Khushali Bank, Kohat Branch (State life insurance) left as legacy by the deceased as per their sharia shares. That petitioners are entitled to receive the Succession Certificate accordingly. That they approached NADRA for grant of Succession Certificate but it was declined for the reason that one or more legal heirs are minors, therefore, there is a factual controversy and they are issued decline certificate Naccordingly.

public, hence, placed and proceeded ex-parte. Accordingly, petitioners were given opportunity to produce ex-parte evidence.

Attorney for petitioner No. 1 namely Ali Zat Khan S/O Noor Baz Ali appeared and recorded his statement as PW-01. Power of attorney is Ex-PW-1/1 Copy of his CNIC is Ex. PW-1/2. Decline Certificate issued by NADRA is Ex. PW-1/3. Death Certificate of deceased Naseeb Ali is Ex. PW-1/4. CNIC of deceased Naseeb Ali, Bank statement, Form B, Family Tree (02 pages) and computerized death registration certificate issued by NADRA are Ex. PW-1/5 to Ex. PW-1/9. He lastly requested for issuance of Succession Certificate in favour of petitioners.

Khyal Meen Ali, relative of petitioners appeared and deposed as PW-02. Photocopy of his CNIC is Ex-PW-2/1. He verified that the petitioners are the legal heirs of deceased Naseeb Ali.

Likewise, court bailiff was directed to verify the list of legal heirs of deceased Naseeb Ali, who submitted his report wherein it was verified that the petitioners are the legal heirs of deceased named above.

In the absence of any rebutting evidence, petitioners are hereby declared as the legal heirs of the deceased named above. Succession Certificate be issued in favour of the petitioners on furnishing surety bonds/undertaking in the sum of Rs: 200,000/- (two lac) with two local & reliable sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this Court to

ZAHIR KHAN the effect that if there appears any other legal heir of the deceased except JuogelJN Crakza bove named legal heirs, they would be responsible to the court, along with a blank stamp paper.

Before closing, it is pertinent to mention that this certificate does not confer any title to the holder of the certificate and does not conclusively determine the shares in the securities/debts, rather this certificate is issued with the sole purpose to recover the securities/debts from the department concerned. Thus, any person(s), if aggrieved, may press his/their rights through a suit before a competent Forum and to recover the amount received on the basis of said certificate to the extent of his/their shares on the basis thereof. Similarly, this certificate does not place bar on the right of any aggrieved person to establish his/their title and entitlement in the dues of the deceased before a competent court of jurisdiction.

In case, if there is any minor (s) legal heir, then share of the minor (s) be kept intact and shall not be dispose of without prior permission of the Court.
