Petitioner through counsel present. Respondents (public at large) have already been placed and proceeded against ex-parte. Ex-parte arguments heard and record perused.

Petitioner namely Bibi Lal Pari Jan widow of Iltaf Hussain, R/O Qoum Mani Khel, Tappa Zakarya Khel, Village Tagha Mela, Tehsil Lower, District Orakzai has filed the instant petition for grant of Guardianship Certificate regarding her minor children namely Saeed Ali, Asma Zahra and Uzma Begum. It has been alleged that petitioner is the widow of deceased Iltaf Hussain who died on 24.02.2022. That father of minor has savings in shape of Special Saving Certificates and after his death, his minors are entitled to received leftover amount lying in National Saving Center, Kohat. It is further alleged that petitioner is the natural guardian of minors named above and the interest of petitioner and minors are common and there is no conflict in their interest, therefore, she may be appointed as guardian of minors named above.


Respondents/public at large were summoned through publication in daily "AWSAF" but no one appeared before the court to contest the instant application, hence, they were placed and proceeded against ex-parte vide order dated 07.10.2022.

Thereafter, petitioner produced three witnesses.

Accordingly, petitioner herself appeared and deposed as PW-01.

PW-1/2. FRC and Form B of minors are Ex. PW-1/3 and Ex. PW-1/4. She lastly requested for the grant of Guardianship Certificate.

Cousin of petitioner namely Naushid Ali appeared and deposed as PW-02. Copy of his CNIC is Ex. PW-2/1. He supported the contents of petition.

Relative of petitioner namely Sakhawat Ali appeared and deposed as PW-03. Copy of his CNIC is Ex. PW-3/1. He also supported the contents of petition.

Thereafter, ex-parte evidence of petitioner was closed.

There is nothing on the case file to suggest that there is conflict of interest between petitioner and her minor children, hence, the Guardianship Certificate, as prayed for, is granted in favour of petitioner subject to furnishing surety bond in the sum of Rs: 200,000/- (Two Lac Rupees) with two local and reliable sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this court with a blank stamp paper. The sureties must be men of means.
