Application for setting aside ex-parte proceedings submitted by learned counsel for defendants. Learned counsel for respondents marked his no objection on the acceptance of application. Resultantly, application is allowed and ex-parte proceedings against Kalaya Orakzai defendants are set aside.

Brief facts of the case in hand are that plaintiff namely Mir Jan Shah has filed the instant suit against the defendants namely Inam Shah and seven others for declaration cum permanent injunction to the effect that suit property fully detailed in the head note of the plaint is the ancestral ownership of plaintiff. That defendants have got no concern whatsoever with the suit property and that defendants were asked time and again to admit the legal claim of plaintiff but in vain, hence, the present suit.
