Order	23/08/2022	<p>Mr. Sana ullah Shah Advocate represented accused/petitioner; whereas, Mr. Zubair APP is in attendance for the State.</p> <p>2. This is the disposal of Post arrest bail application presented by accused/petitioner Muhammad Sadeeq s/o Khan Wazeer r/o Qaum Mishti, village Mishti Bazar, Orakzai.</p> <p>3. On 21st of July, 2022, the local Police on getting information regarding the murder of female on the pretext of honor rushed to the Emergency Room of DHQ Hospital, Mishti Mela; where, Mst Bibi Sherina, wife of Meer Khan was found murdered with fire arm. The son of deceased namely Muhammad Shafiq son of Meer Khan aged about 16-17 years, was present there and reported the matter to the Police. The incident was reduced into writing of Murasila which was later on converted to FIR bearing No. 27 dated 21-07-2022, registered under Section 302/311 of the Pakistan Penal Code 1860, in Police Station Misthi Mela. Accused has been remanded to Judicial Lockup which necessitated presentation of instant post arrest bail which is under consideration.</p> <p>4. Learned counsel for accused/petitioner and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for State were heard at length and file gone through.</p> <p>5. Perusal of the case file reflects that though the accused/petitioner is directly charged and the offence carries capital punishment but there is no eye witness of the occurrence. As per joint statement of Muhammad Shafiq (complainant), Mir Khan (husband of deceased) and Khan</p>



Wazir (father of deceased), they have got no objection if the accused/petitioner is released on bail. All these facts render the case of the accused as that of further inquiry.

6. For what has been discussed above, instant bail petition stands allowed subject to furnishing bail bonds to the tune of Rupees one lac fifty thousands (150,000/-); with two sureties; each in the like amount; to the satisfaction of this Court. File of this Court be consigned to District Record Room after its necessary completion and compilation within the span allowed for; whereas, copy of this Order be placed on record of Police to be returned accordingly.
