Arguments heard and record gone through.

2. Accused/petitioner, Najab Ur Rehman s/o Zarat Shah seeks his post-arrest bail in case FIR No. 92, dated 28.09.2022 registered u/s 9 (d) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa CNSA at Police Station Kalaya, wherein, as per contents of FIR, the local police during routine patrolling having laid a picket on the spot, stopped a person having blue colour plastic bag in his right hand on his way from Headquarter chowk. The search of the plastic bag holding by the accused/petitioner led the complainant to the recovery of 05 packets of chars, each weighing 1000 grams, making a total of 5000 grams of chars. Hence, the present FIR.

3. It is evident from the record that the accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the FIR

with a huge quantity of chars recovered from his possession and the offence for which the accused/petitioner is charged, attracts prohibitory clause of section 497 Cr.P.C. Moreover, sufficient material is available on file which reasonably connect the accused/petitioner with the commission of offence. Hence, the accused/petitioner is not entitled for the concession of bail at this stage. Accordingly, for the stated reasons, bail petition in hand stands dismissed being meritless. Consign.
