bag holding by the accused/petitioner led the

complainant to the recovery of 05 packets of chars,

each weighing 1000 grams, making a total of 5000

grams of chars. Hence, the present FIR.

3. It is evident from the record that the accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the FIR



with a huge quantity of chars recovered from his possession and the offence for which the accused/petitioner is charged, attracts prohibitory clause of section 497 Cr.P.C. Moreover, sufficient material is available on file which reasonably connect the accused/petitioner with the commission of offence. Hence, the accused/petitioner is not entitled for the concession of bail at this stage. Accordingly, for the stated reasons, bail petition in hand stands dismissed being meritless. Consign.
