BAIT ULLAH VS THE STATE

ORDER

DPP, Umar Niaz for the State and Sana Ullah Khan Advocate for accused/petitioner present. Record received. Arguments heard and record gone through.

2. Accused/petitioner, **Bait Ullah** s/o Muhammad Jamil seeks his post-arrest bail in case FIR No. 93, dated 30.09.2022 registered u/s 9 (d) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa CNSA at Police Station Kalaya, wherein, as per contents of FIR, the complainant along with other police officials during routine patrolling having laid a picket on the spot, stopped a person having a blue colour plastic bag in his right hand on his way from Yarli Khel Bazar. The search of the plastic bag led the complainant to the recovery of 06 packets of chars, each weighing 1000 grams, making a total of 6000 grams of chars. Hence, the present FIR.

3. It is evident from the record that the accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the FIR with a huge quantity of chars recovered from his possession. The offence for which the accused/petitioner is charged, attracts prohibitory clause of section 497 Cr.P.C. Moreover, sufficient material is available on file which reasonably connect the accused/petitioner with the commission of offence. Hence, the accused/petitioner is not entitled for the concession of bail at this stage. Accordingly, for the stated reasons, bail petition in hand stands dismissed being meritless. Consign.
