Order No 06	12.12.2022	<p>Accused namely <b>Ghafoor Rehman s/o Janab Khan, R/O Qoum Mishti</b> charged in case FIR No. 17, Dated: 01.08.2022, registered U/S 11(A)CNSA and 468/471 PPC at police station Dabori, U/Orakzai produced in custody. DPP for the state present.</p> <p>Accused submitted an application for disposal of case wherein pleading his guilt. He waived his right U/S 241-A Cr.P.C willfully. Notice u/s 243 Cr.P.C given to the accused in response of which he placed himself at the mercy of the court. Formal charge framed against the accused to which he pleaded guilty.</p> <p>As the accused pleaded his guilt and has prayed for mercy of the court. Therefore, keeping in view the plea of guilt of the accused and while taking lenient view accused is convicted under section 11A(CNSA) and sentenced to simple imprisonment for 01 month and fine of Rs. 300,000/- and in default of the payment of fine he will have to undergo simple imprisonment for <b>10</b> days more. Also, the accused is further convicted u/s 468/471 PPC for 01 month simple imprisonment for each of the said sections. All these sentences shall run concurrently.</p> <p>As the accused has already passed 34 days in total in the judicial lock-up, Orakzai, therefore, benefit u/s 382-B Cr.P.C is extended to him. Thus, the accused should be immediately released after passing <b>06</b> days more in the judicial lock-up, Orakzai if not required in any other case.</p> <p>Case property shall be disposed off as per the law.</p> <p>File be consigned to record room after its necessary completion.</p> <p><b>Announced</b> 12.12.2022</p> <p>(Rehmat Ullah Wazir) Senior Civil Judge/JM, Orakzai (at Baber Mela)</p>
