## SUIT FOR DECLARATION, CUM PERPETUAL AND MANDATORY INJUNCTION

#### **SUMMARY JUDGEMENT:** 20.10.2022

Brief facts of the case in hand are that the plaintiff, Ameena Nawab has brought the instant suit for declaration cum perpetual and mandatory injunction against the defendants, referred hereinabove, seeking declaration therein that her EHMAT WALLAH WAL

rights of the plaintiff and liable to correction. That the defendants were repeatedly asked to correct the date of birth

of plaintiff but they refused, hence, the instant suit.

- 2. Defendants were summoned, who appeared through their representative namely Syed Farhat Abbas, who submitted written statement.
- 3. During the scheduling conference within the meaning of order IX-A of CPC, it was revealed that the matter involved in the instant case is very petty in nature, which can be decided through summary judgement as per relevant record. To this effect notice was given to the parties that why not the case in hand be decided on the basis of available record without recording lengthy evidence, as the primary aim and objective of Amended Management Rules in CPC is, "to enable the court to
  - a. Deal with the cases justly and fairly;
  - b. Encourage parties to alternate dispute resolution procedure if it considers appropriate;
  - c. Save expense and time both of courts and litigants; and
  - d. Enforce compliance with provisions of this Code."

The relevant school's record-keeper was summoned and the one Muhammad Kamran appeared as CW-01 who produced Admission and Withdrawal Register, the copy of which is Ex.CW-1/1 and according to that, the date of birth of the plaintiff is 11.05.1996.

Learned counsel for plaintiff and representative for defendants heard and record gone through.

Record reveals that plaintiff through instant suit seeking declaration therein that her correct date of birth is 11.05.1996 according to school record while it has been wrongly mentioned as 11.05.1987 in her CNIC by the defendants, which is wrong, ineffective upon the rights of the plaintiff and liable to correction. Plaintiff in support of her contention produced the copy of the admission and withdrawal register of the Khyber Model High School Sarozai, the copy of which is Ex.CW-1/1 and the copy of her Matric DMC and Matric Certificate, BISE Peshawar, wherein the date of birth of the plaintiff has been mentioned as 11.05.1996, so these documents of school of the plaintiff clearly negate the incorporation of her date of birth as 11.05.1987 in her CNIC. Further, there is no countered document available with the defendants to rebut the document produced by the plaintiff in upport of her stance, which establishes that the date of birth of the plaintiff has wrongly been mentioned in her CNIC that is against the facts and circumstances. The available record is sufficient to decide the fate of the case and no further

5. Consequently, upon what has been discussed above and the jurisdiction vested in this court under order IX-A and XV-A of CPC, suit of the plaintiff succeeds and is hereby decreed

evidence is required to be produced by the parties.
