SUIT FOR DECLARATION, CUM PERPETUAL AND MANDATORY INJUNCTION

SUMMARY JUDGEMENT: 27.10.2022

1. Brief facts of the case in hand are that the plaintiff, Muhammad Azeem has brought the instant suit for declaration cum perpetual and mandatory injunction against the defendants, referred hereinabove, seeking declaration therein that his correct date of birth is 10.02.2007 according to Matric DMC while it has been wrongly mentioned as 11.09.2003 in the record of the defendants, which is wrong, ineffective upon the rights of the plaintiff and liable to correct the date of birth of plaintiff but they refused, hence, the instant suit.

- Defendants were summoned, who appeared through their 2. representative namely Mr. Irfan Hussain, who submitted written statement.
- During the scheduling conference within the meaning of 3. order IX-A of CPC, it was revealed that the matter involved in the instant case is very petty in nature, which can be decided through summary judgement as per relevant record. To this effect notice was given to the parties that why not the case in hand be decided on the basis of available record without recording lengthy evidence, as the primary aim and objective of Amended Management Rules in CPC is, "to enable the court to-
 - Deal with the cases justly and fairly; а.
 - Encourage parties to alternate dispute resolution *b*. procedure if it considers appropriate;

Save expense and time both of courts and litigants; and Enforce compliance with provisions of this Code."

Learned counsel for plaintiff and representative for defendants heard and record gone through.

AND CIVIL BODEL MERS Record reveals that plaintiff through instant suit seeking declaration therein that his correct date of birth is 10.02.2007 according to Matric DMC while it has been wrongly mentioned as 11.09.2003 in the record of the defendants, which is wrong, ineffective upon the rights of the plaintiff and liable to correction. Plaintiff in support of his contention

produced the his original Matriculation documents, the copies of which are placed on file, issued by BISE Kohat, wherein the date of birth of the plaintiff has been mentioned as **10.02.2007,** So, Matric DMC of the plaintiff clearly negate the incorporation of his date of birth as 11.09.2003 in record of the defendants. Further, there is no countered document available with the defendants to rebut the document produced by the plaintiff in support of his stance, which establishes that the date of birth of the plaintiff has wrongly been mentioned in record of the defendants that is against the facts and circumstances. The available record is sufficient to decide the fate of the case and no further evidence is required to be produced by the parties.

- 5. Consequently, upon what has been discussed above and the jurisdiction vested in this court under order IX-A and XV-A of CPC, suit of the plaintiff succeeds and is hereby **decreed** as prayed for with costs. Defendants are directed to correct the date of birth of plaintiff as **10.02.2007** in their record and in the CNIC of the plaintiff.
- 6. File be consigned to the record room after its necessary completion and compilation.
