
APP for the state present. Counsel for accused/petitioner present. Complainant absent. Record already received. Arguments heard and case file perused.

Accused/petitioner namely Rafil son of Aqal Shah, resident of Qaum Utman Khel, Miagano Kallay, Tehsil Lower, District Orakzai is seeking his post arrest bail in Case FIR No.23 dated: 15.03.2022 U/S 506,34 PPC, Police Station Kalaya, District Orakzai.

Perusal of record would reveal that offence with which accused/petitioner is charged does not fall within the ambit of prohibitory clause of Section 497 Cr.PC. In such like cases grant of bail is a rule and refusal is an exception. No extra ordinary circumstances exist for refusing bail of accused/petitioner. No empty shell has been recovered from the spot. Co-accused namely Muhammad Shafiq and Aqal Shah have already been released on bail therefore, rule of consistency also apply to the case of accused/petitioner. Investigation has already been completed and accused/petitioner is no more required to the local police for further investigation and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused/petitioner behind the bar.
