Accused Ajmeen and Abdul Rasheed on bail present.

Accused Peer Rehman is absconding. Accused Abdul Salam, Qismat Khan, Muhammad Rasheed and Gul Majeed have already been acquitted on the basis of compromise. Complainant Muhammad Shareef along with elder/Malak Kalish Khan present.

Complainant stated that they have patched up the matter with the accused Ajmeen and Abdul Rasheed. They are not interested in further prosecution of the above named accused and have got no objection on their acquittal and to this effect, statement of complainant was separately recorded which is duly thumb impressed by him. Copies of CNICs of complainant and injured Mst. Shahida Bibi are Ex.PA and Ex.PB. He produced compromise deed Ex.PC. Copy of CNIC of elder/Malak Kilash Khan is Ex.PD. Offences are compoundable. Resultantly, accused Ajmeen and Abdul Rasheed are acquitted from the charges leveled against them on the sole ground of compromise. The accused are on bail. Their bail bonds stand cancelled. Sureties are discharged from the liabilities of the bail bonds.
