Petitioners/defendants have sought rejection of plaint on the

ground that plaintiff has got no cause of action to file the instant suit

and that there is no way, therefore, there is no right of way or any

other easement. On the other hand, claim and contention of

respondent is that he has got a right of way and he has been

peaceably and openly enjoying the same as an easement, as of right,

without interruption for the last 20 years. The averments of the

parties consist of issues of question of law and fact which cannot be

determined without recording evidence of the parties. The application

does not cover the four corners of Order-VII Rule-11 CPC. Hence,

the application for rejection of plaint stands rejected. No order as to

costs.
