Registered.</p> <p>Accused, (1) Qeemat Khan, (2) Talib Khan, (3) Rasheed Khan, all s/o Zafar Khan, (4) Luqman s/o Gul Khan, (5) Sawab Khan s/o Talib Khan, (6) Roghat Khan s/o Akhtar Jaan, (7) Khaista s/o Khalifa and (8) Said Wali s/o Saleem Khan, all r/o Caste Afridi, Stori Khel, Terayi Kaley are charged in case FIR No. 01, Dated 08.01.2023, u/s 302/324/148/149 PPC of Police Station Kalaya, wherein, as per contents of FIR, on 08.01.2023 the local police on receipt of information regarding the occurrence, reached the spot and found the dead bodies of Ameen Khan s/o Zarif Khan, Muhammad Nawaz s/o Muhammad Rasool, Izat Khan s/o Said Jamal, Muhammad Khan s/o Abdul Sattar and Awal Khan s/o Haider Khan where at about 1750 hours the complainant, Noorab Khan made a report to the local police to the fact that they have got enmity with caste Afridi over a landed property named as Terayi Kaley where they have hired a goatherder for herding cattle who was time and again asked to leave the disputed property but in vain. That on the eventful day at about 1700 hours, he along with the above-named deceased as well as Muhammad Asif and Zarwali Khan were present in the house of Sher Baz when the absconding accused duly armed came there and started firing upon them, resulting in the death of the above-named deceased, while he (complainant), Muhammad Asif and Zarwali Khan remained unharmed. The motive was stated to be the enmity between the parties over a disputed property.</p>

<p>Contin. Order No.1</p>		<p>The accused despite being proceeded u/s 204 Cr.P.C as well as u/s 87 Cr.P.C, failed to appear before the court. Hence, they were proceeded u/s 512 Cr.P.C. The court of learned Judicial Magistrate-I, Tehsil Court Kalaya, after recording the statements of as many thirteen (13) PWs, has sent the file to this court for issuance of perpetual warrant.</p> <p>Perusal of the case file reveals that the above-named accused are deliberately avoiding their lawful arrest and there is no likelihood of their arrest in near future; hence, as per record, a prima facie case exists against the absconding accused, (1) Qeemat Khan, (2) Talib Khan, (3) Rasheed Khan, (4) Luqman (5) Sawab Khan (6) Roghbat Khan (7) Khaista and (8) Said Wali. They are declared proclaimed offenders. Perpetual warrants of arrest be issued against them and District Police Officer, Orakzai is directed to enter their names in the register of proclaimed offenders. All the legal course be adopted for their arrest and they be brought before the court as and when arrested. Case property be kept intact till final disposal of the case.</p> <p>Order announced.
