Offences u/s 337-A(i), 337-L(i), 147, 149 PPC are bailable in nature while punishment for offence u/s 337-F(ii) does not fall within the ambit of prohibitory clause of section 497 Cr.PC. In such like cases grant of bail is a rule and refusal an exception. No extra ordinary circumstances exist to justify departure from the said role.
