Special attorney of petitioners along with counsel present. Counsel for the petitioners submitted an application to the effect that Bakhtawara was also wife of deceased Khial Bat Khan and her name be added in the panel of petitioners being legal heir. He requested for acceptance of the instant application. Arguments heard and record perused.

As per record and the declined certificate produced by the special attorney of the petitioners, the name of Bakhtawara is mentioned in the legal heirs of the deceased Khial Bat Khan. Thus, in the interest of justice, I hereby accept the instant application. Name of Bakhtawara be added in the panel of the petitioners. Application disposed off accordingly. Moharrir is directed to do the needful.

Petitioner's evidence present and recorded as PW-01 to PW-03 and closed. Arguments heard and record perused.

The petitioners 1. Qismat Bibi (widow) 2. Bakhtawara (widow), 3. Hidayat Ullah (son), 4. Muhammad Adnan (son), 5. Muhammad Shoaib (minor son), 6. Hameed Ullah (minor son) and 7. Bibi Shadma (minor daughter) all residents of Village Bari Khel, Tehsil Upper, District Orakzai have filed the instant petition against respondents, public at large, for issuance of Succession Certificate being LRs of deceased Khial Bat Khan. That the amount of Rs. 1,086,881.02/- left as the legacy of deceased lying in account No. 3096503231 in National Bank of Pakistan, Zargiri, Hangu. According to the petitioners, they are LRs of the deceased named above and there is no other legal heir except them. That they approached NADRA for grant of Succession Certificate but it was declined for the reason that petitioners No. 5 to 7 are minors, therefore, they were issued decline certificate accordingly. Decline certificate is placed on file.

4. The respondents i.e., public at large was served through notice in daily newspaper "Ausaf" dated 22.05.2024, but no one appeared before the court, so ex-parte proceedings were initiated. During the course of ex-parte evidence, one Hidayat Ullah being special attorney of the petitioners appeared as PW-01. He produced the following documents.

Ex. PW-1/2 & 1/8: Copies of CNICs of petitioners No. 3 & 1 respectively.



Succession Certificate be issued on the stamp paper and copy of the same be placed on file. If any legal heir/objector appear in future, the petitioners and the sureties will be responsible for the payment. Parties are left to bear their own cost.
