

DSP Legal Sikandar Khan along with District Attorney present.</p> <p>Petitioner submitted an application for correction of respondent No. 04 and stated that the same may be read as DC Orakzai instead of DC Hangu. District Attorney and counsel for the respondents recorded no objection on the application by putting their signatures; therefore, in view of no objection of the respondents, the application is accepted and the name of respondent No. 04 be read as DC Orakzai instead of DC Hangu. Muharrir is directed to make the requisite correction with reference to this order.</p> <p>Today reply to the application for contempt of court submitted by the respondents through District Attorney wherein, it is categorically mentioned that the respondents have not handed over the possession of the suit property to any third person rather they have left the suit property vacant without handing over possession to any person.
