


The perusal of Inquiry Report transpires that the accused/official has admitted his misconduct to the extent of late coming to the Office. Order No. 03	30.09.2024	Accused/official present in person and heard in detail. The accused/official explained his late coming/absence from duty on 27.08.2024 being Chehlum day on which the cellular networks in Hangu area were suspended owing to security reasons and due to which he could not communicate with the office. This fact has also been reflected in written reply of the accused/Official. The accused/official seeks apology for his negligence and makes a sincere gentleman commitment for not repeating the same in future. He also seeks an opportunity to mend his behavior. The Inquiry Officer has also recommended consideration of apology tendered by the accused/official. Keeping in view the recommendations of Inquiry Officer coupled with requested-apology and gentleman commitment by the accused/official, I, being Competent Authority, accept the apology and exonerate the accused/official from the charges against him in the instant inquiry. The Accused/official, being fresh into the service having barely three-year service, is hereby strictly warned to reform himself and not to repeat the same negligence in the future failing which he might lose his job.
