Order No.02	30.09.2024	<p>DPP, Umar Niaz for the State at Baber Mela accused Mir Azam Khan on bail not present.</p> <p>The above-named accused is charged for the offence u/s 462-K PPC vide FIR no. 17, dated 17.04.2024 of Police Station Kurez wherein, as per contents of FIR, the complainant, SDO Rehmat Ullah TESCO through a Murasila addressed to the SHO of Police Station Kurez made a report to the local police to the fact that on 24.10.2023, the absconding accused was found committing illegal theft or misuse of electricity which amounts to financial loss burdened upon his department.</p> <p>After completion of investigation, the prosecution submitted challan along with application for discharge of the accused on the grounds mentioned therein.</p> <p>It is evident from the record that the complainant has not mentioned the name of the official who had caught the accused while committing illegal theft or misuse of the electric power besides no statement has been recorded to this effect. There is nothing available on file which reasonably connects the accused with the commission of offence and it would be a futile process to proceed with the case.</p> <p>In view of the what is discussed above, on acceptance of the application of prosecution, the accused named above is discharged of the offence.
