

		<p>Accused/petitioner, Socha Gul on ad-interim pre-arrest bail in person with his counsel present. Record received. Complainant Muhammad Yasir not present.</p> <p>The above-named accused/petitioner seeks confirmation of his ad-interim pre-arrest bail in case FIR no. 56, Dated 25.09.2024, u/s 56 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Mineral Act, 2017 registered at Police Station Kurez, wherein, as per contents of FIR, the complainant on 08.08.2024 made a report to the local police to the fact that the accused/petitioner with co-accused have obstructed mining operations of a holder of a mineral title namely, Sardar Khan and have illegally taken some articles. Hence, the present FIR.</p> <p>Arguments heard and record perused.</p> <p>Perusal of case file shows that though the accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the FIR but the offense for which the accused/petitioner is charged does not fall within the prohibitory clause of section 497 CrPC. Moreover, no inquiry has been conducted by the complainant to dig out the real facts of the case connecting the accused/petitioner with the commission of offence which clearly indicates the malafidi on behalf of the local police. Furthermore, BBA petitions of co-accused with similar roles have already been confirmed by this court. In these circumstances, no useful purpose of the prosecution would be served to commit the accused/petitioner to police custody except the probability of injustice harassment of the police. Accordingly, the BBA petition in hand stands accepted and the ad-interim pre-arrest bail earlier granted to the accused/petitioner vide order dated 15.10.2024 is confirmed on the strength of existing bail bonds.</p> <p>Order announced.
