Accused namely Amta Gul and Tota Gul on bail along with counsel present.</p> <p>Accused persons have already been released on bail vide order, dated: 07.09.2024 by my learned predecessor in office in bail petition No. 20/BA. The bail in addition to appraisal of merits was based on compromise between the sides. Complainant in his statement had stated that he would have no objection if the accused persons are released on bail, and later acquitted from the charges. That he has pardoned them in the name of Almighty Allah. Statement of the complainant already recorded in this context are available on file, and have been alluded to in the bail order.</p> <p>Given that the offence is compoundable, and the parties have already entered a compromise, the court does not see any reason to proceed with the case. Besides, in view of record, once the principal witness has entered compromise, the likelihood of conviction is slim. Therefore, accused persons facing trial are acquitted from the charges leveled against them. As they are on bail, their bail bonds stand cancelled and sureties are discharged from the liability of bail bonds.</p> <p>File be consigned to record room after necessary completion.</p> <p>Announced 04.11.2024</p>
